



INSTRUCTIONS.

ART. 10.—Of the General Order of the Local Government Board, dated the 20th March, 1879, relating to the Special Rates Accounts required by Section 37 of the 39 & 40 Vict. c. 61, to be audited, provides that the Collector shall, previous to each audit, make out an *Unpaid Rates Statement*, in the Form (No. 6) in the Schedule to the Order, containing a Statement of the Rates allowed during the last half-year, with the dates of their allowance, and showing the name of every person rated in respect of whom there shall be at the end of the half-year for which the audit is being held, any arrears of the Rate or Rates made before that in the course of collection on the last day of that half-year, with the other particulars set forth in the Form. He shall submit such Statement to one of the Overseers for his signature, and shall produce the same to the Auditor at the audit.
