Rules and Instructions respecting the duties Of Lamplighter to the Town Trust of Brading

- 1. The appointment to the post of Lamplighter is to commence on the 1st October 1919 to the 15th April 1920.
- 2. The lamps are to be lighted from the 1st October 1919 to the 15th April 1920 every night with the exception of four nights before full moon and two nights after, but should it be dark on these nights then the lamps are to be lighted and put out earlier if the moon should show up bright.
- 3. The Lamplighter shall commence lighting the lamps half an hour after sunset and begin to put them out at 9.30 p.m. every evening. In the event of any use being made of the New Town Hall the lamp at the Bull Ring to be left to the last.
- 4. The lamps are to be kept clean both inside and outside and otherwise properly attended to, and the Town Trust will provide the oil and all other things necessary for use.
- 5. The Lamplighter to carry out all the duties of the post to the satisfaction of the Trustees.

I hereby agree to undertake the duties of Lamplighter for the Brading Town Trust, subject to the above Conditions, for the sum of £32 payable by two equal instalments the first at Christmas 1919 and the second on April 1920, and will carry out the above Rules and Instructions to the best of my ability.
