**Demand Note for General and Special Rates
and Water Rates and Charges.**

PARISH OF BRADING (Special Drainage District).

Mr. *The Brading Town Trust* or occupier.

THE ISLE OF WIGHT RURAL DISTRICT COUNCIL demand payment of a **General Rate** and **Special Rate** in respect of the financial half-year commencing on the first day of April, 1934, and of the arrears (if any) of former rates, **now due from you**, as below.

The **General Rate** is made at 2/8 in the pound (including 1d. for additional items). The **Special Rate** is made at 8d. in the pound upon the rateable value of hereditaments as shown below; except that it is made upon one quarter only of that rateable value in the case of tithe, tithe rent charge, land covered with water or used as a canal or as a towing path for a canal, or as a railway constructed under the powers of any Act of Parliament for public conveyance.

The Council also give notice that the amount of the **Water Rate** and charges payable by you for the same period are as set out below —
