With a view to providing public telephone facilities during the hours when Post Offices, Shops and other premises at which Call Office facilities are usually available, are closed, the Post Office is erecting telephone kiosks in the open, and it is desired to erect such a kiosk in Brading.

The most central position would appear to be in the vicinity of the Town Hall and I should be glad to know if the Town Hall Trust would agree to the erection of the kiosk inside the railings in the position shewn on the attached sketch.

If the proposal is agreed to it would be necessary to cut the railings and this would be done at the expense of the Post Office.
