Brading Hall.

Proposed Heating.

I estimate the cost to supply and install a Boiler in the basement under the East anti-room, remove the grate in anti-room and connect flue of boiler to this, run the necessary pipes and supply and fix Two Radiators of 57 feet heating surface each side of Hall, also to supply and fix a small Radiator in the East anti-room in place of the present fire which will be removed, and leave all in working order, at the sum of **Fifty five pounds to Sixty pounds** (£55. to £60.)

I have been offered some Second hand Radiators and a Boiler which would give less heat, but perhaps would be sufficient, ie Six Radiators of 36 feet each, in this case three would be put each side, also a boiler of a smaller

size, and if these were used there would be a saving of about **Fifteen pounds** (£15.).

The cost of two New Stoves as at present would be about **Eight pounds Ten shillings.** (£8-10-0.).

Awaiting the favour of your instructions, as I have obtained the refusal of the Second Hand Boiler and Radiators until Thursday next, and should you decide to have either scheme done, we could put the work in hand almost at once.
