Notes.—Income Tax, Schedule A :—  
 (1) The Landlord is bound under a penalty of £50 to allow, on production of this Receipt, out of the first payment made on account of Rent after the date of the receipt, the amount of Income Tax actually paid under Schedule A, up to an amount not exceeding for the whole year the amount of the tax on the Rent payable for the year at the rate or rates of tax paid in respect of such Rent.  
 (2) Repairs.—Where the cost of maintenance, repairs, insurance and management of any lands or houses, according to the average of the preceding five years, exceeds the allowance for repairs already granted in the assessment, a further allowance may normally be claimed by the owner. Further information can be obtained, if desired, on application to the Inspector of Taxes, whose address will be furnished by the Collector on request.
