WATER UNDERTAKINGS (MODIFICATION OF CHARGES) ACT 1921.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Isle of Wight Waterworks Company have made application to the Minister of Health under the above Act for an Order modifying sections 25 and 27 of the Isle of Wight Waterworks Act 1861 so as to enable them to make charges for water supply for domestic purposes in the water limits within which they are empowered to supply water in accordance with the following Scale:-

Where the annual Rackrent or value of the Premises so supplied with water shall not exceed Five Pounds per annum, at a Rate not exceeding Four pence per week.

Where such Rackrent or value shall be above Five Pounds and not exceed Ten Pounds per annum, at a Rate per centum per annum not exceeding Fifteen Pounds.

Where such Rackrent or value shall be above Ten Pounds and not exceed Twenty Pounds per annum, at a Rate per centum per annum not exceeding Twelve Pounds.

Where such Rackrent or value shall be above Twenty Pounds per annum, at a Rate per centum per annum not exceeding Ten Pounds.

In addition to the Rates hereinbefore defined, where a house contains more than one Watercloset, for every additional Watercloset the sum of Ten shillings per annum.

A copy of the application and of all documents submitted to the Minister in connection therewith may be inspected and extracts thereof made free of charge at the Company's Offices, Fitzroy Street, Sandown, Isle of Wight, between the hours of 10 a.m. and 4 p.m. Copies of the documents may be purchased from the Company at the usual charges made for copying.

Any person desiring to make any representation or objection with reference to the application may do so by letter addressed to the Secretary, Ministry of Health, Whitehall, London, S.W.1. not later than *1st May* 1922.

A copy of any such representation or objection must be sent at the same time to the undersigned.
