

Brading Town Trust.

At a meeting held in the Town Hall on Tuesday the 28th day of April 1903. the clerk read the following Report.

I beg to Report that acting in accordance with a Resolution passed at the last meeting, a Survey and plan of the property in Pit Lane has been made, also that a Notice Board was prepared and placed on the land, advertising the property to be let on Lease for a term of years. I have had an offer for the land from Mr. W. H. Deuham, Monkton Street, Hyde, who will take a Lease of the property, subject to the Trustees approval, for a term of 99 years at an improved Ground Rent of £3.10.0 per annum. In the meantime certain conditions laid out by the Charity Commission must be carried out by the Trustees before anything definite can be arranged respecting the above offer.
