At RYDE, on Tuesday, before Col. H. G. Gore Brown,
V.C. (in the Chair), and other Justices.

WHEN RATES ARE DUE.

A number of persons were summoned for non-payment of district and other rates. The Chairman asked the assistance of the Press in correcting what appeared to be a rather general impression, that rates were payable only at Lady-day and Michaelmas respectively. He said, as a matter of fact, urban rates were payable within 14 days of demand, and poor rates within 7 days.
