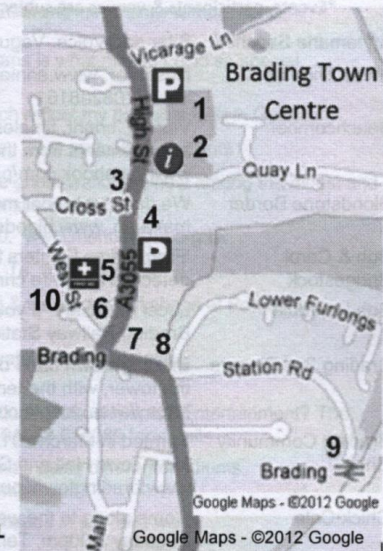

The historic town of Brading is situated between Ryde and Sandown on the A3055. SatNav postcode PO36 0DQ. Parking is available in the town's two pay & display car parks. On-street parking is very limited.

Wightlink, Red Funnel and Hovertravel operate regular ferries from the mainland to the Isle of Wight.

Southern Vectis bus routes 2 (daytime) & 3 (daytime & evenings) serve the town with an additional hourly night bus service on Friday and Saturday.

Island Line operate regular trains running from the direction of Ryde pier head and Shanklin to Brading Station.

Brading is situated on popular walking and cycling routes linking the town to St Helens, Bembridge, Yarbridge and beyond.

All venues are fully accessible. Concessionary parking is available for blue badge holders in the Town Car Park adjacent to St. Mary's Church Hall. Concessionary parking does not apply in the Bugle Inn pay & display car park.

A first aider will be stationed at the Dark Horse PH when available.

Brading Bash is informally coordinated by residents and business people of Brading.
